



Fayette County Food Distribution Resources

(updated October 2025)

Fayette County Food Pantry - Recipients may receive food at the Pantry once a month. They are required to show financial need by filling out the "Federal and State Eligibility to Take Food Home Form" based on income. These forms are kept and updated each time a recipient comes to the pantry. We are a choice pantry which allows families to choose what their family will use from a large variety of both fresh and canned food items. The amount of food received is based on family size. Food Pantry Hours: Monday, Wednesday, Friday 1-3pm; Produce Alley: 1st Friday/3rd Monday.

Heritage Food Pantry - is a ministry of Heritage Memorial Church that provides a food pick-up to residents of Fayette County that meet the MidOhio Food Bank income requirements. Photo ID and proof of residence in Fayette County are required for this resource. It's open Mondays from 9 a.m. to 11:15 a.m. Ph: 740-636-1111.

Military Chow Hall - The Military Chow Hall Food Pantry and Service Center is a 501(c)(3) organization that operates on the second and fourth Saturday of each month from 9am to noon. The Military Chow Hall Food Pantry and Service Center serves veterans and active-duty service members of the following branches:

- Air Force
- Army Coast Guard
- Navy
- Marines
- Space Force
- *National Guard and Reservists (service outside of weekend training is required)*
