



Highland County Food Distribution Resources

(updated October 2025)

Greenfield Area Christian Center - provides food, clothing and basic household items to those living in the Greenfield Exempted Village School District. Assistance is available once a month. Ph: (937) 981-5172.

Highland County Community Action Emergency Pantry - The food pantry provides 3 meals per household member for a 3 day supply of food. Applicants must be residents of Highland County and have a gross income under 200% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines. Applicants may receive food pantry assistance no more than once a month and only once within a 30-day period.

Samaritan Outreach Services - Operates a food pantry serving anyone living within a Highland County School System. To make an appointment for service, call Mondays or Tuesdays from 10am to 4pm. All pantry visits are by drive-thru appointment only. No walk-in service is available. Telephone: 937-393-2220

Miscellaneous Resources

740 Rescue Kitchen - At the 740 Rescue Kitchen, the mission is to fight hunger, reduce food waste, and strengthen our community by transforming surplus food into nutritious meals for those in need. There are several distribution locations in our region.

Find Help - also a resource finder that has a large reach. Food resources are sorted by meals, emergency food, pantries, and delivered meals. You can print information by resource in this platform.

FoodFinder - connects the people looking for emergency food to the programs and places that offer it. The finder is updated by programs so does not have all information included.

FreshTrak - provides what is available in many communities on a daily basis. It does not include everything available nor does it have resources in every community
