[Homeless Shelter](#) - 615 8th Street, Portsmouth 740-353-4085 Tuesdays and Thursdays from 10 AM-2 PM. Requires photo ID and number in home; eligible every 30 days.

[Second Presbyterian](#) - Corner of 8th and Waller, Portsmouth 740-353-4159 Wednesdays 10 AM-2 PM. Closed first Wednesday of month. Requires photo ID, social security cards for everyone in home, proof of residency; eligible every 30 days.

South Webster Food Pantry - 8 Potts Street, South Webster 567-644-3720 Monday 9-2:00 or call for emergencies and senior boxes first Tuesday of month. Requires photo ID and recent mail to establish residence.
