Inpatient outcomes report 2022

The Inpatient Rehabilitation Unit at Adena Greenfield Medical Center was awarded three-year accreditation by the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) in 2020 and is recognized by CARF as a Stroke Specialty Unit for rehabilitation. AGMC is the only facility in our service area with these specialty accreditations.

The Inpatient Rehab Unit provides patients with an individualized therapy plan, six days a week. Our traditional and innovative therapy methods show our commitment to providing patients with the highest standard of care. Some of the things that set AGMC apart include the enabling garden, community re-entry, driving screening, certified hand therapist, lymphedema and a variety of other unique techniques.

How do we compare?

Our patients leave with a greater level of function. Our Functional Independence Measure (FIM) change score was 26.0 compared to 21.2 nationally.

Our patients improve more in a shorter period of time. Our average length of stay was 10.3 days, compared to 25 days nationally. Our length of stay efficiency was 3.44 compared to 1.92 nationally.

AGMC is also able to provide a less intensive level of skilled care. If a patient is not able to tolerate the higher level of therapy, they can choose to come to a skilled bed (within our hospital setting) and receive the same excellent care and services at a lower level of intensity. AGMC provides individualized care based on the patients' needs and tolerance.

Outpatient Physical, Occupational and Speech therapy are available to patients to provide a consistent continuum of care. AGMC also provides Outpatient Neuropsychology services.

More of our patients return to a community setting. 87.3% of our patients were discharged back to a community setting, compared to 80.5% nationally. 7.7% of our patients were discharged to an acute setting compared to 5.7% nationally. 4.9% were discharged to long-term facilities compared to 11.7% nationally. Zero patients expired and one patient had an interruption during their stay.

^{*(}LOS) length of stay efficiency measures the rate of functional improvements, so a higher value is better.

In summary, more AGMC rehab patients were discharged to their homes in a shorter length of time, with greater improvement, than the national average.
