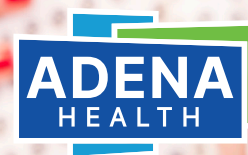

What is the difference between screening and diagnostic mammograms?

A screening mammogram is for women who have no current breast symptoms. It is a routine test done yearly beginning at the age of 40 for most women. The images will be obtained then read by a radiologist at a later time. At Adena a physician order is not necessary for a screening mammogram when you are age 40 or older.

A diagnostic mammogram is ordered when a lump or any other breast abnormality is found. It may also be ordered by a radiologist if a suspicious area is identified on a screening mammogram or previous mammogram. For diagnostic mammograms you must have a physician order.

If an abnormality is found on a mammogram, Adena offers a seamless system of care that allows us to make a diagnosis and begin treatment as early as possible. For further screening, Adena offers Breast Ultrasound, Breast MRI, Ultrasound-Guided Breast Biopsy and Stereotactic Breast Biopsy.

Symptoms of breast cancer



Lump/thickening in the breast or under the arm



Inverted/retraction of the nipple



Redness or flaky skin in the nipple area



Any change in the size/shape of the breast



Skin dimpling



Nipple discharge
