

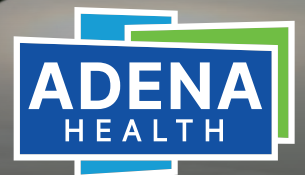

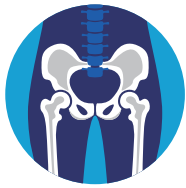

Struggling with deep hip or groin pain?

Are you dealing with sharp groin pain or hip pain when sitting?

Pain that flares up when you walk, run, twist, or squat? Maybe even a clicking or catching deep in your hip? It may be more than a pulled muscle.

These symptoms are common in people with:

- Labral tears
- Hip impingement (FAI)
- Cartilage damage
- Loose fragments inside the joint

If you've tried rest, ice, or physical therapy and your hip still isn't improving, the real issue may be inside the joint. That's something you can't see or fix immediately, but Adena Health has the expertise to help.

Many patients describe this pain the same way:

*"It feels **deep, sharp, and keeps coming back** no matter what I do."*

There's a minimally invasive treatment option available right here in southern Ohio.

Adena is the only health system in the area offering hip arthroscopy. This small-incision procedure treats conditions like hip impingement and labral tears to help you get back to the things you love — without traveling to Columbus or Cincinnati.

The procedure is performed by David Pettit, MD, an orthopedic surgeon fellowship-trained in sports medicine and hip arthroscopy. He grew up in Portsmouth and is committed to bringing advanced orthopedic care close to home. "

The benefits of hip arthroscopy over a traditional open procedure are that it's much smaller incisions, it's minimally invasive, and it results in a faster recovery and less pain," says Dr. Pettit. "You go home the same day and sleep in your own bed after surgery."

If these symptoms sound familiar, it may be time to take the next step.

You don't have to guess what's going on with your hip — and you don't have to keep living with daily pain or giving up activities you love.

- Waiting rooms

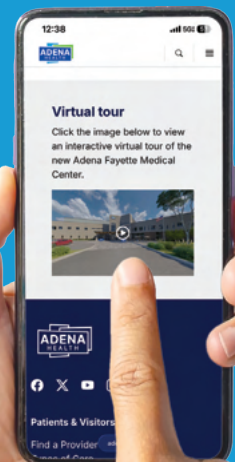

When should a spot be checked?

Changes in your skin can sometimes be an early sign of skin cancer, one of the most common cancers in the U.S.

Many skin growths are harmless, but **changes in size, color, shape, or texture are worth a closer look.** When skin cancer is found early, treatment is often simpler and highly effective.

Some people are at higher risk and benefit from annual or more frequent screenings, including those with:

- A personal or family history of skin cancer
- Fair skin, freckles, or light-colored hair and eyes
- A history of severe sunburns or tanning bed use
- Numerous or unusual moles
- A weakened immune system

Relief from enlarged prostate – without incisions

Men experiencing urinary problems from an enlarged prostate now have access to a **highly effective, minimally invasive option** at Adena Health.

The Holmium Laser Enucleation of the Prostate, or HoLEP, procedure treats benign prostatic hyperplasia (BPH) by removing excess prostate tissue – without external incisions and often as an outpatient procedure.



Why HoLEP matters:

- No surgical cuts
- Short recovery time
- Effective even for larger prostates
- Long-lasting relief (repeat procedures are rarely needed)

Matthew Christian, MD, has already helped hundreds of patients find relief using this advanced approach, and he's here to help others regain comfort, confidence, and quality of life.

Common signs that indicate it may be time to seek care:

- Urinary symptoms that don't improve with medication
- Ongoing issues after previous procedures
- Pain, bladder stones, or catheter dependence

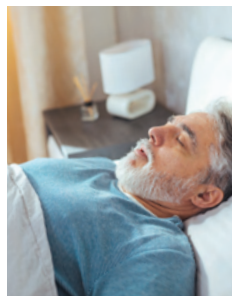


Sleep better – without the mask

If Continuous Positive Airway Pressure (CPAP) therapy hasn't worked for you – whether it's too loud, uncomfortable, hard to clean, or difficult to travel with – the Sleep Center at Adena Regional Medical Center offers another option for obstructive sleep apnea:

Inspire upper airway stimulation therapy

Inspire is a small implantable device that works with your natural breathing to keep your airway open during sleep. A breathing sensor sends gentle stimulation to the nerve that controls tongue movement, helping prevent airway blockage – **without a mask or bedside machine**. Patients turn the device on and off with a handheld remote.



The device is placed during a short outpatient procedure, with the **stimulator implanted beneath the skin in the upper chest** and a small sensing lead positioned to detect breathing patterns.

Most patients return home the same day. Adena's Sleep Center team, including specially trained ENT surgeons, helps determine whether Inspire may be right for you.
