Top 10 Reasons to go to the Emergency Room

- **1. Heart Attack:** Signs that last two or more minutes including pressure, fullness, squeezing or pain in the center of the chest; tightness, burning, or aching under the breastbone; chest pain with lightheadedness
- 2. Stroke: Signs include sudden weakness or numbness of the face, arm or leg on one side; sudden dimness or loss of vision; trouble talking or understanding speech; unexplained dizziness; sudden and severe headache; unsteadiness or sudden falls
- **3.** Serious accidents
- **4.** Fall on, or hit to the head, followed by confusion, blurred vision, or headache.
- **5.** Loss of consciousness
- **6.** Sudden and severe abdominal pain or headache
- **7.** Seizures
- **8.** Poisoning or suspected poisoning
- **9.** Bleeding that will not stop or deep cuts
- **10.** Suicidal or homicidal feelings
